List of Accepted Recyclables (Subject to Change) ROADSIDE/DRIVE-IN CARTS

Place in roadside/drive-in carts labeled: "Plastic, Glass, Aluminum & Tin Containers Only" AKA Commingled

Glass, Aluminum, Tin & Plastics #1 – 7, including: Soda, water, shampoo and mouthwash bottles and peanut butter jars, milk, water and juice jugs, detergent bottles, yogurt and margarine tubs. ***NO PLASTIC BAGS, PACKAGING OR STYROFOAM***

Place in roadside/drive-in carts labeled: "Paper & Cardboard Only"

Corrugated cardboard, newspaper and inserts, junk mail and envelopes, phone books, catalogs and magazines, books, paperboard (cereal, cracker, soda boxes), dairy and frozen food boxes, office paper, brown paper bags, shredded paper (placed in brown paper bag and staple closed)

*** Do NOT recycle: Tissue paper or paper products contaminated *** *** with grease or food ***

DROP-OFF SITE

Place in separate containers at drop-off site, 10564 Old Stage Rd, Sister Bay, WI: (Fees may apply)

- Appliances (fridge, freezer, dishwasher, humidifier, etc.)
- Batteries (rechargeable, lead acid, alkaline, & laptop)
- Construction & Demolition Material (wood, carpet, drywall, aggregate, etc)
- Electronics (computer monitor, components, TV, radio, etc.)
- Florescent light bulbs & ballasts
- Fruit & vegetable compost
- Holiday lights

- Office Equipment (copier, printer, & fax Machine)
- Plastic #1- 7, Aluminum, Tin, & Glass
- Plastic Film (bags, packaging, wrappers)
- Propane 20# tank (must be empty)
- Scrap Metal
- Shingles (sorted & unsorted)
- Tires (on or off rim)
- Used Motor Oil (in closed container and labeled)
- Yard Waste (invasive species are considered Trash)
